WE NEED YOUR SUPPORT

Joining our lottery will make a difference. The more players that join, the more profit we make. All profits from the lottery will go directly to **Flint House**. The contribution you make helps us to carry on with our work.

HOW IT WORKS

For just £1 per month you will be allocated with a five digit Lottery number, which is unique to you and remains yours for as long as you keep playing. You can purchase more than one entry if you wish. On the 28th day of every month, the lucky winners are selected at random and prize cheques are issued and posted directly to you, so there is no need for you to claim. You must be 16 or over to enter.

PRIZES

The Charity's aim is to give away seven cash prizes a month. A total maximum prize pot of **£1,500** per month which breaks down as follows: **£1,000** (66.6% of the total prize pot), **£200** (13.3% of the total prize pot), **£100** (6.6% of the total prize pot), and **4 x £50** (3.3% of the prize pot).

This prize giveaway will be possible when there are at least 2,500 entries into the lottery. If there are fewer entries than this, the total prize pot will be made up of 50% of the monthly proceeds and will be broken down by the same percentages shown previously into the seven prizes.
